EnerGuide Rating System—Blower Door Test Waiver

The waiver applies to homes where vermiculite insulation has been detected and is exposed to the interior of the home.

Blower door testing is used to determine the amount of air leakage in the building envelope and whether there is the potential for combustion spillage. If the energy advisor observes vermiculite insulation exposed to the interior of your home, blower door testing cannot be performed as per the *EnerGuide Rating System—Technical Procedures* and the presence of vermiculite will be recorded as a warning on the *Homeowner Information Sheet*.

Instead of a blower door test, a default air leakage value based on the weather location and year of construction of your house will be used to produce the EnerGuide rating. Additionally, the energy advisor will not be able to check if there is the potential for combustion spillage if your house has combustion-spillage-susceptible appliances.

By signing this waiver, I acknowledge the following:

- A blower door test was not performed as part of my EnerGuide home evaluation because vermiculite that is exposed to the interior of my home was detected;
- The energy advisor was not able to perform a combustion spillage test;
- I have been directed to the Health Canada website which includes relevant information on vermiculite-based insulation that may contain asbestos; and
- My EnerGuide rating is likely not as accurate as it would have been had a blower door test been performed.
